

Field maple cultivar ‘Red Shine’

Acer campestre ‘Red Shine’

Origin. A cultivar was bred by Van den Oever, in the Netherlands in 1980.

Morphology. Small tree or clump-like tree up to 4 m high. Cork bark. Dark purple leaves in spring, in summer become dull, dark greenish-red, later dark green.

Ecology. Medium winter-hardy to winter-hardy cultivar. Leaf color is bright, if it grows in sunny place. Tolerates shade. Grows well in neutral or alkaline soils, tolerates acidic soil. Drought tolerant. Resistant to diseases and pests.

Importance. Decorative greenery plant for large and medium-sized plantations.
